2010 Pit Trash Shoot Out Rules

There will be 2 classes : Open Class (run what ya brung) and Sports man Class

This is a run what you brung competition.

2. Registration will start September 1st, and will close October 22nd, 2011.

a. The entry fee for each two man team is \$200 per rig for Open Class and \$25 per rig for Sportsman Class

b. Each team will have to be paid in full before competition starts on October 22nd.

C. We Except Visa, Master Card and Discover over the phone! OR mail entry fee money order, or check to Pit Trash Challenge - 9960 E. Chicago Rd. Jerome, MI 49249.

D. Register by sending an email to Pittrashchallenge@hotmail.com with the following info:

3. Each team will consist of a two man team, in one rig.

4. Teams will not be allowed to walk the course before 8:00am the day of the competition.

5. There will be a mandatory driver meeting at 11:00am each morning of the competition.

A. Starting order will be determined by lottery drawing at the drivers meeting. The order to draw for position will be determined by each team's registration date.

6. Competition will start at 12:00pm each day, and run until we are done.

7. Helmets, long pants, gloves, and protective gear must be worn by both driver & spotter at all times during the run.

8. Each rig must have proper tow points, fire extinguisher, winch, safety belts, and proper and safe cage to run in this event.

9. Rigs can use the following fuel sources, pump gas, racing fuel, propane, and Nitrous.

10. Winch Weights must be used for all winching.

11. This is an overall timed event.

12. Each rig will be called to the line and must be ready to go when called. If you cannot make your starting call, you will go to the end of the running order and be assessed a 5 minute penalty at the end of your run.

13. This will be an air horn start, with an air horn finish, and will be monitored and recorded by a Master Time Keeper at the end of each run. No challenges will be acknowledged or addressed. Master Time Keepers recorded record of the time is the law.

14. Spotter must be in vehicle and buckled in when the rig crosses the finish line at the end of the run.

15. Each team has the option of a second run after all teams have had a chance to complete their first run of the course.

If a team chooses to re-run the course, the time of the second run must be used as the official run time of that team. The first time will be dropped, and will not count.

16. Each team will have 45 minutes to complete the course.

a. If there are no teams that finish the course, distances will be recorded and the longest distance ran will determine the winner.

B. In the event of equipment failure, the team has the remainder of the 45 minutes to repair the rig and continue their run. At the end of the 45 minutes the run is officially over regardless of where that team is on the course.

C. Each team can throw in the red towel if they feel at any point they cannot continue through the course due to inability to complete the course, equipment failure, or any other reason they feel necessary. That distance will be recorded in the event we have to use that as a determining factor to choose a winner of the event, if no one completes the full course.

D. There will be a 1 minute penalty for each out of bounds infraction. Each infraction will be identified by the field judges and reported back to the master time keeper at the end of the run.

17. In the event of a tie, we will choose one leg of the course to be ran by the two teams for the best time. We will choose which team will run first by the toss of a coin. Caller will be determined by the date of registration, first registered will call the toss.

18. Any confrontations, foul language, and threats towards any official will result in the disqualification of that team and an immediate ejection from the park.

19. Prize money will be awarded as follows for Open Class: 1st place \$500.00, 2nd place \$300.00, 3rd place \$200.00

4th place 10 visit park pass, 5th place 5 visit park pass.

Payout for the Sportsman Class will be based on the number of entries we have, and how much is in the pot.

20. Teams for all classes are welcome to enter the park on Friday Night October 22nd, 2010 and camp all weekend
